A Motion was made by Nick White to approve the Minutes from both the regular Parks meeting of June 1, 2004, and the special meeting on June 7, 2004. Motion was Seconded by Carol Petros, and Carried.

**Treasurer's Report:**

No Financial Statement was available. Additional bill to added to current bills; Pam Blough, \$1,631.25 for plan design of Cleveland Avenue Project, and \$656.25 to prepare State Grant for North Lake Park.

**New Business:**

Kim Risk asked if there is anything the Lakeshore Youth Soccer Association could help with on the Cleveland Avenue Parks development at this time. Their assistance will valuable in the near future.

Scott Smith (S.W.M.S.A.) reported that their tournament went well. Fields at Cleveland and Roosevelt Park were utilized to accommodate 84 youth teams (14 years and under). Scott presented a donation to the Lincoln Charter Township Parks Commission of a check for \$750.00. They hope to use these fields for another future tournament.

A replacement Parks Maintenance worker has been hired, returning the staff to its full capacity of three.


