Fee Clarifications Viia (Mobile Home Site)

When installing a site service in a park, the permit application should include the application fee, service, plus the number of park sites. When installing a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit should include the application fee and a feeder. This shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor. When installing a HUD mobile home or a modular home on a private property, a permit should include the application fee, service and feeder.

Viib(Fixtures, floor drains, special drains, and water connected appliances include):

Water closets, sink (any destinations) stop sink, drinking fountain, floor drain, water outlet or connection to any makeup water tank, bathtub, emergency eye wash, bidet, condensate drain, roof drain, water outlet or connection to heating system, lavatories, emergency shower, cuspidor, washing machine, grease trap, water outlet or connection to filters, shower stall, garbage grinder, dishwasher, acid waste drain, starch trap, connection to sprinkler system(Irrigation), laundry tray, water outlet cooler, refrigerator, embalming table, plaster trap, water connected sterilizer, urinal, ice making machine, water heater, bed pan washer, water softener, water connected dental chair, autopsy, water connected still, water connected to carbonated beverage dispensers. PLUS ANY OTHER FIXTURE, DRAIN, OR WATER CONNECTED APPLIANCE NOT SPECIFICALLY LISTED.

DOMESTIC WATER TREATMENT AND FILTERING EQUIPMENT: A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modifications to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated waster piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed, and the installation compiles with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists. It shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorder in item #25 for \$5.00 each, and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

MEDICAL GAS SYSTEMS: shall include the application fee, one Special/Safety Inspection-Medical Gas System #26, and the estimated number of additional inspections.

Instructions For Completing Application

General: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with Lincoln Charter Township. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.

The name of the inspector and the telephone number will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location, type of inspection and permit number.

Expiration Of Permit: a permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REINSTATED.
