I will cooperate with the DBS and assume the responsibility to arrange for necessary inspections. #1 inspection – setbacks before backfill. #2 inspection – final after work is completed.

SWIMMING POOL FILLS

Lincoln Charter Township and the Lincoln Charter Township Fire Department, are pleased to offer this “extra” service for our residents. To make arrangements, please call:

RULES

1. All arrangements for filling swimming pools shall be made with the **Lincoln Charter Township Fire Department** appointed fireman.
2. Pool owners must contact the appointed fireman two (2) days in advance before the pool is to be filled.
3. It is **NOT** permissible for anyone other than those authorized by the **LINCOLN CHARTER TOWNSHIP FIRE DEPARTMENT** to open a fire hydrant for private or public purposes.
4. There is **NO** “tank” delivery of water. In order to have a pool filled by the **LINCOLN CHARTER TOWNSHIP FIRE DEPARTMENT**, you must have a fire hydrant available to your property within 1000 feet.
5. The pool owner will be expected to pay in full the bills for this service, presented at the time of the pool fill, in the following manner:
 - A. A separate bill is prepared for the cost of the water used, by the gallon, and for the equipment, payable to Lincoln Charter Township. Equipment: \$5.00 per each fifty (50) foot length of fire hose necessary to reach from the fire hydrant to the pool. (EXAMPLE: 200 feet from hydrant to pool – four (4) hoses times \$5.00 equals \$20.00)
 - B. A separate bill is prepared for the cost of the labor for each fireman involved. A separate check should be made out for each fireman filling the pool. Labor: \$20.00 per hour per man. It is necessary to have two (2) fireman on a pool fill at all times. (The normal well pre-pared pool fill takes about one and a one-half to two hours).
 - C. A separate check for the scheduling fee, in the amount of \$5.00, shall be made payable to the fireman.

Average prices from previous fills are listed below.

20 x 40 pool including water, hose and labor:	\$186.00
16 x 32 pool including water, hose and labor:	\$102.00
